Get Started with BiT


Step 1:

Go to KSUTAB.org and click on **E-TOOLS**.



Step 2:

Click on BiT.




Step 3:

Click Get Started with BiT.

Step 4:

If you do not yet have an account, click **Sign up**, provide your email and a password, and click **Create Account**.




Now you can log in and begin creating your site inventory.



Step 5:

If you are new to BiT, you will need to create a new program before you can enter data (as explained on the **Welcome to BiT** page). Each program will contain one or more sites.




Naming a Program

Note: It is helpful for the program name to refer to the sites being tracked and managed within that program.


Example Program Names:

- City of Savannah 2024
- Gas Stations
- Abandoned Buildings
- Illegal Dump Sites
- Petroleum Sites





After creating a new program, you will see three panels in your display window






Step 6:

Use the first panel to choose the program and site you wish to work on. You can also use the navigation bar to move through your database.







The navigation sections will continuously update as you add data. The navigation bar is organized to assist you through the process of setting up your brownfields site inventory. Once you create a site, the list will expand.
