

What Data Are Collected?

- ACRES collects property-specific data in the online Property Profile Form (PPF)
- Property Profile Form Part I: Property Information
 - Property Name
 - Property Address
 - Property Size
- Property Profile Form Part II: Environmental Activities
 - Assessment & cleanup activities and funding
 - Contaminants found and media affected
 - Engineering and Institutional Controls
- Property Profile Form Part III: Additional Property Information
 - Redevelopment activities and funding
 - Property history and future uses




When Do I Submit Data in ACRES?

Data should be updated in ACRES as soon as there is new activity to report



What is a Work Package?


- A work package is created when you click a link to "Enter data" to add/update information. This "package" moves through the data entry and approval process. Only one work package can exist at a time for a CA and associated property. Once approved, a new work package can be created to record new data.
- An open work package is any package that you are currently working on that has not yet completed the review process.





What is the ACRES Workflow?


- The series of actions and states that a work package must pass through before being completed.
- The status of a work package indicates where it is in the workflow.





How Are Data Organized?


- Each signed Cooperative Agreement is one record in ACRES.
- A single property record may be associated with more than one cooperative agreement.
- There is no limit to how many CAs a property can be associated to.





How to add an existing property to a new CA


- On the My Accounts card on your homepage, select the My CAs button.
- On the My Cooperative Agreement screen, locate the CA to which you will add the property.
- Select the +View link.
- Select the +Add a Property button.






How to add an existing property to a new CA

- On the Step 2 Search for Existing Property (Avoid Duplication) screen, search for the existing property by city and state.
- Once you have searched and located the existing property, select the checkbox in front of the property record.
- Click the Add selected property button to add the property to the CA.



Cooperative Agreement Details page


The Cooperative Agreement home page gives an overview of your CA. This page is a great way to view all data currently entered under your CA including properties associated, assessment, and cleanup activities.





Property Details page

The Property home page gives an overview of all your property data. You can view all data currently entered under your property including assessment and cleanup activities, leveraged funding, and redevelopment.
