## 1st Step Internally for our Tribe, we ask the following:

- Does this grant meet the objective for our Brownfields Program?
- Does our staff have the capability to meet the grant deliverables?
- Does the Tribe have contractual support, procurement support and the financial support?
- Does the Tribe have support from management internally and with our Grants Development Team?



#### **Making Tough Decisions**

When applying for the grant:

- Identify short-term goals
- Identify long-term goals

Are the goals achievable?





### **Building Capacity**

Does the grant build capacity for our Brownfields Program?

- Tribe will this grant help the Tribe meet their goals and objectives?
- Staff will this grant help build skills and technical expertise with Brownfields work?
- Resources will this grant help expand technical resources and equipment?
