

Brownfields Grant Updates

CERCLA Section 128(a) Allocation

- FY25 allocation was completed in April
 - 173 cooperative agreement recipients for approx. \$105.4 M
- FY26 cycle will begin late September with requests due mid-December
- Anticipate completing allocation in March 2026, with awards in June – Sep 2026





Brownfields Grant Updates

Brownfields Job Training Grants

- **FY25 Brownfields Job Training:** EPA selected 16 communities to receive about \$7.7 Million.
- The FY26 JT NOFO has been published, and it will close on Sept 26, 2025.
 - Entities that were awarded an FY25 EPA Job Training Grant are **not** eligible to apply in FY26.
 - Brownfields Job Training Coalitions are now eligible.
 - Non-lead coalition members can not have an open EPA Brownfields Job Training Grant.
 - Responses to each threshold criterion are required and must be included as an attachment to the Narrative.

Brownfields Grant Updates

MARC Grants

- FY25 Assessment, Revolving Loan Fund (RLF), and Cleanup Grant and FY25 RLF Supplemental Funding selections were <u>announced</u> <u>in May 2025</u>. Grants will be awarded once all legal and administrative requirements are satisfied by selected recipients.
- EPA anticipates offering the following in fall 2025:
 - FY26 Multipurpose Grants
 - FY26 Assessment Grants
 - FY26 Cleanup Grants
- The FY26 guidelines and applicant resources will be made available on EPA's website at epa.gov/brownfields/marc-grant-application-resources.
- EPA anticipates publishing the FY26 RLF Supplemental Funding guidance for high-performing RLF recipients in winter 2026.

- FY26 is the last year for IIJA funding
- FY26 128(a) Funding Guidance
- Community-wide Assessment Grant for States and Tribes (CWAGST)





Our five types of technical assistance (TA)

Grant

- 1. TAB (TA to Brownfield Communities)
- Topic-specific, national
- ✓ Independent resource
- ✓ TA providers are EPA grantees who were competitively selected
- ✓ Communities access TA providers directly
- ✓ TA available at **grantee's** discretion

Grant

3. Section 128(a) Technical Assistance Grant (TAG)

- ✓ State/tribal resource
- ✓ TA provided via grant to 128(a) recipients who request TAG funding
- ✓ TA must assist small communities, tribes, rural areas, or disadvantaged areas

Contract

- 4. Targeted Brownfields
 Assessment (TBA)
- 5. Land revitalization TA for site reuse planning
- ✓ EPA-directed resource
- ✓ TA providers are **EPA contractors**
- ✓ Communities access TA providers via regional office
- ✓ TA available at **region's discretion** (consults with OBLR)


EPA's Technical Assistance to Brownfields Communities

Technical Assistance to Brownfields (TAB) Providers

Assist specific regions with TA and training to communities and other stakeholders on brownfield issues, such as:

- preparing grant applications;
- performing site inventories;
- reviewing historical information;
- design of investigation/ sampling/field analysis; and
- cleanup and redevelopment planning.

EPA's Brownfields Technical Assistance

Technical Assistance to Tribal Nations and Entities Kansas State University (through 2028)

- TA available to entities eligible for CERCLA 104(k) and 128(a) Grants.
- Goals:
 - ✓ Build partnerships to support reuse of Tribal lands (e.g., housing, recreation, finance, etc.);
 - ✓ Build Tribal expertise for safely reusing brownfield sites through outreach, training and coaching;
 - ✓ Connect Tribal members with experienced Tribal environmental response professionals;
 - ✓ Facilitate meetings between Tribal members, developers, lenders, and others involved in the cleanup and reuse of brownfield properties; and
 - ✓ Facilitate brownfield reuse efforts by supporting Tribal community and other stakeholder involvement activities including development of fact sheets and other outreach materials.


